The peace and serenity of winter has fallen on Camp Perry, in stark contrast to the hustle and heat of the National Matches during the summer time.

2007 was a busy year for the *Friends of Camp Perry*. In conjunction with ORPA, we sponsored two extremely successful and popular pop-up shoots, the March pistol shoot last spring and the fall rifle, or Snowflake Shoot, in November. Participation in the 2007 rifle shoot showed approximately a 70% increase over the 2006 shoot! Judging by the license plates seen in the Viale parking lot, shooters from as far away as Wisconsin are coming in to shoot.



The length of the waiting line at the registration tent was also a definite indication of the increase in the popularity of the pop-up matches. Funds raised by these events helps the Friends in its mission to support the troops and their families who train at Camp Perry and maintain Camp Perry as a historical landmark. Our next pistol pop-up match is scheduled for Saturday, March 29, 2008, so mark your calendars accordingly and bring plenty of ammo!



The Friends also initiated the Memorial Brick program selling inscribed bricks for the Shooters Memorial Plaza to be built at the intersection of Niagara and Lawrence roads in front of the flagpoles. After some delays, construction is expected to get underway in April. The plaza will be comprised of some 1,400 bricks with up to 52 characters per brick. We are hoping that all the state associations and clubs will purchase bricks to support this project.
